The Springfield Township Board of Trustees held a meeting Thursday, June 16, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at the Springfield Township Town Hall, 2459 Canfield Road, Akron, Ohio.

The meeting was called to order by Dean Young. Patty Price, Secretary, called the roll. Roll Call: Mrs. Davis (here); Mr. Young (here); Mr. DiLauro (here).

ADMINISTRATIVE

ADM 157-16 Dean Young: I move to amend Motion #155-16 to specify that the Acting Chief position was full time, with first date of service on June 13, 2016. Seconded by Deborah Davis. Roll Call: Mrs. Davis (yes); Mr. Young (yes); Mr. DiLauro (yes).

ADM 158-16 Dean Young: I move to appoint David Hoover as the full time Chief of Police for Springfield Township at a rate of \$38.03/hr. with date of service in this capacity beginning June 16, 2016. Seconded by Joe DiLauro. Roll Call: Mrs. Davis (yes); Mr. Young (yes); Mr. DiLauro (yes).

Ted Weinsheimer, Road Superintendent: Monthly Road Department Report - not available.

ROAD 165-16 Joe DiLauro: I move to approve ‘A Resolution Authorizing the Board of Trustees of Springfield Township, Summit County to prepare and submit an application to participate in the Ohio Public Works Commission Local Transportation Improvement Program for the Canfield Road Improvements.’ Total project cost of approximately \$320,000.00 with the Township committing up to \$96,000.00 which will be appropriate if awarded. Seconded by Dean Young. Roll Call: Mrs. Davis (yes); Mr. Young (yes); Mr. DiLauro (yes).

ROAD 166-16 Joe DiLauro: I move to approve ‘A Resolution Authorizing the Board of Trustees of Springfield Township, Summit County to prepare and submit an application to participate in the Ohio Public Works Commission Local Transportation Improvement Program and State Capital Improvement Program for the Canfield Road Improvements.’ Total project cost of approximately \$320,000.00 with the Township committing up to \$160,000.00 which will be appropriate if awarded. Seconded by Dean Young. Roll Call: Mrs. Davis (yes); Mr. Young (yes); Mr. DiLauro (yes).

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Dean Young: These two Road Resolutions are kind of ‘in the alternative.’ We don’t know if either one will be awarded.

ROAD 167-16 **Joe DiLauro:** I move to approve Melway Paving Company as the successful bidder for the Pontius Road Project and award the contract in an amount not to exceed \$222,302.00 based on the Summit County Engineer’s office review and recommendation. This is an Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) funded project. OPWC’s funding share of 70% for \$155,611.40, Lake Township’s funding share of 15% for \$33,345.30 and Springfield Township’s funding share of 15% for \$33,345.30 with each partner paying their share directly to the contractor. Springfield Township’s share paid from fund line 1000-330-360-0101. Seconded by Dean Young. Roll Call: Mrs. Davis (yes); Mr. Young (yes); Mr. DiLauro (yes).

Dean Young: This is an attempt to increase money for a project and our share is a small amount.

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ZONING DEPARTMENT

Pat Ryan, Zoning Administrator: Monthly Zoning Department Report.

The Zoning Department completed 74 complaint investigations: 54 investigations were nuisance related and included:

The Springfield Township Zoning Commission has recommended approval with modifications of a text amendment submitted by Joe Palmer representing Towpath Trail High School. The recommended amendment includes 1) In Table 5.03-A, separate the listed use of Educational Facilities (primary and secondary) into 2 separate categories, primary and secondary; 2) In Table 5.03-A,

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Educational Facilities (primary) conditionally to be permitted in the residential districts R-1, R-2 and R-3 with existing Use Specific Standards Section 5.04(K); 3) In Table 5.03-A, conditionally permit Educational Facilities (secondary) in residential districts R-1, R-2, R-3, and nonresidential districts C-1 and C-2 with Use Specific Standards Section 5.04(L); 4) Use Specific Standards Section 5.04(L) to include all of the Use Specific Standards in Section 5.04(K) and add 3 more standards.















DUMPSTER SURROUND ENLARGED PLAN

 COORDINATE SIZE OF DUMPSTER WITH SERVICE




PRIVACY FENCE DETAIL




SIDE ELEVATION


FRONT ELEVATION




SIGN SECTION DETAIL




